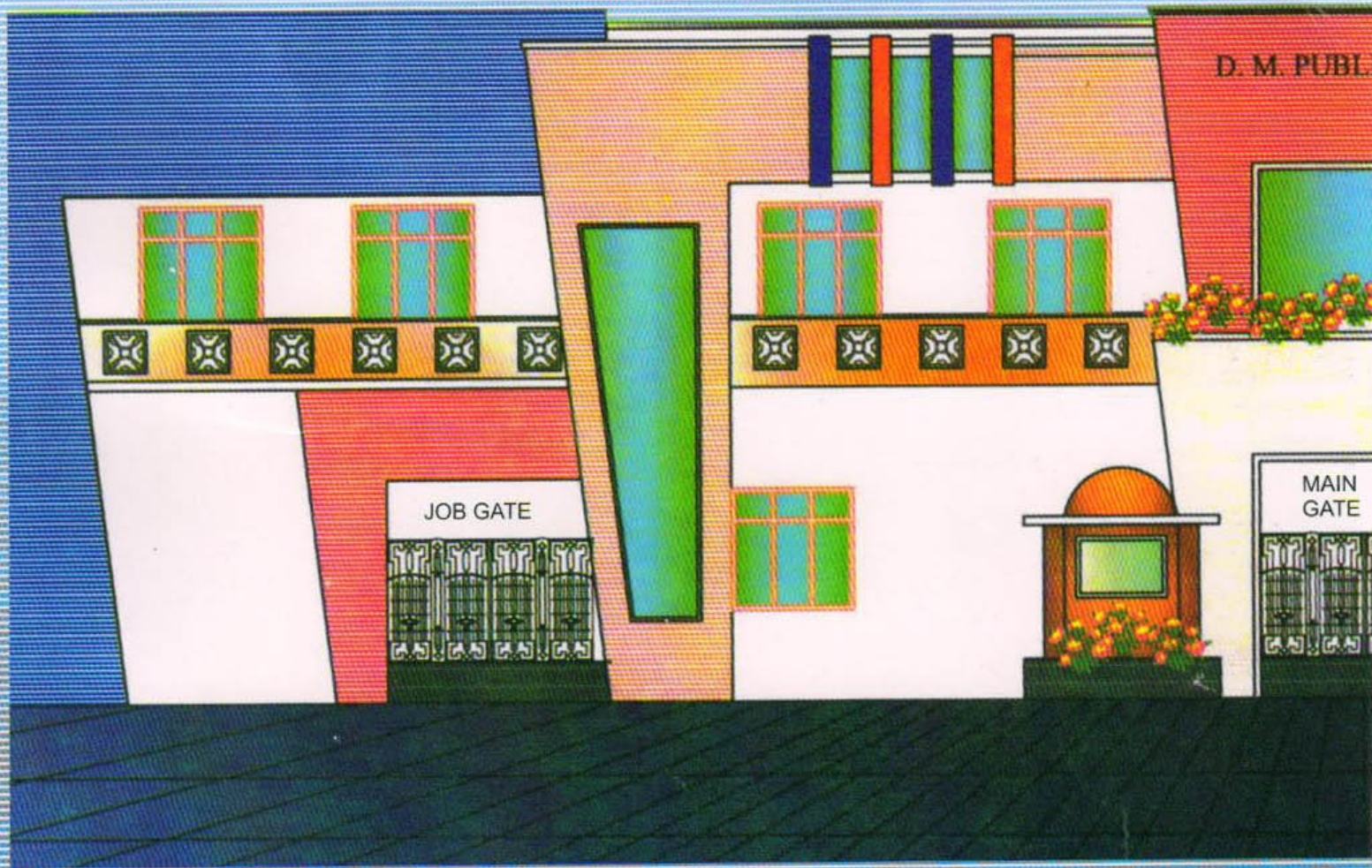

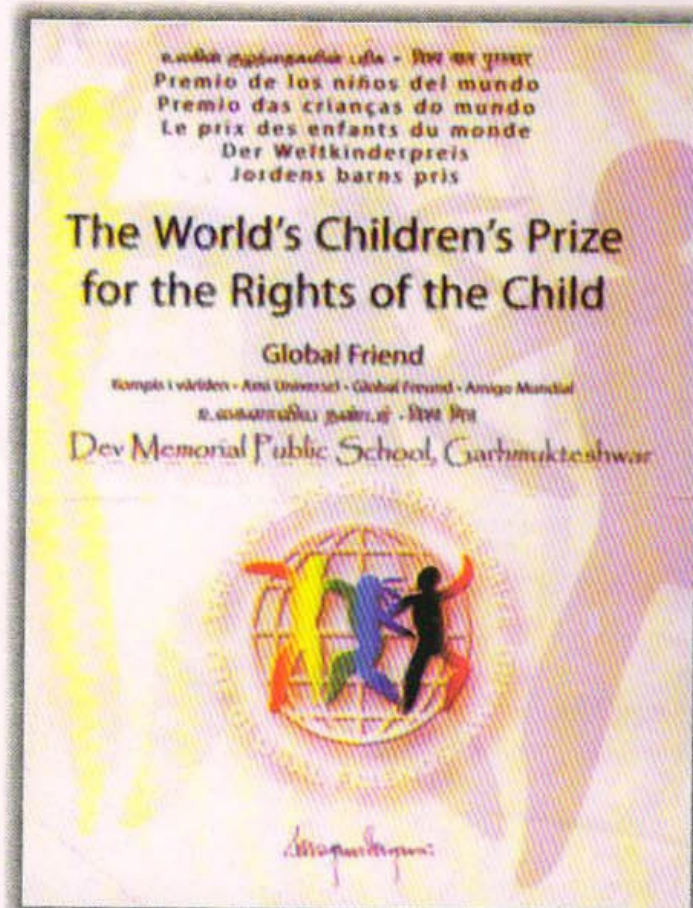

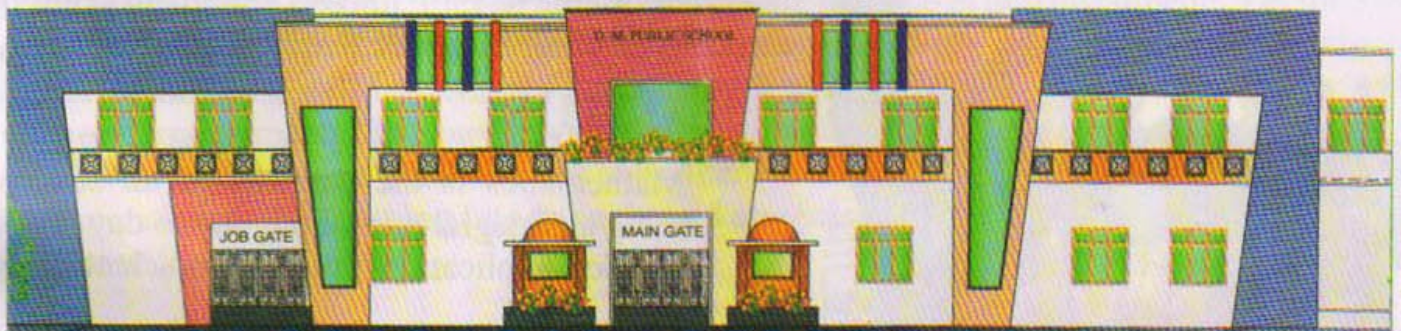

TRANSPORT



Presently schools buses ply on scheduled routes. **Admission** to the school **does not** necessarily mean allocation of a seat in the **School's Bus**. In case of change in residence, adjustment to another bus cannot be guaranteed. Bus users are advised to reach their bus stop

10 minutes before the scheduled time. **No discontinuation of bus facility will be allowed during the academic session.** Eleven month charges are payable in two instalments, i.e. for 5 + 6 months Payable in **April & Oct.** Pupils who do not **behave in disciplined and courteous manner in the bus**, will be debarred from using it and will be required to **make their own transport** arrangements. The bus service provided by the school is a facility to the best of our ability. We try to provide a good service and adhere to the timings. However, the school is in no way responsible for bus **coming late or early and any injury or accidents** caused to the child or any other unforeseen mishap.

LABORARORIES

The school has Well Equipped Laboratories for Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Accountancy, Sociology, Maths & Physical Education. These Labs provide ample opportunities to the students to do practical work and develop their scientific outlook.



COMPUTER

Computer Literacy program is the need of hour in modern age. Computer has become an integral part of our daily life. The school lab is equipped with latest technology like P-4 and internet facilities for the use of students from primary to Senior Secondary levels.

PHYSICS

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

EDUCATIONAL VISITS, CAMPUS & TOURS

Outings, Picnic and visits to historical palaces are arranged from time to time. One Educational tour is compulsory from class IV onwards and one picnic for lower classes during each academic session.

GAMES & SPORTS

School has a natural lush green Athletic track of 200 meter besides Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton courts and Football & Cricket grounds. Regular games and athletic events are being organised to have the concept of sound health. Our students (boys & girls) are participating regularly in CBSE Sports meets and we have won about 70 medals in Athletic Events including Gold Medals in CBSE Meet at National Level.

ADMISSION

Pupils are admitted at the beginning of the session in March / April as per Govt. guidelines. Admission are made if a child has basic skills and attitude for the class applied for, in compulsory subjects. A **Valid School Leaving Certificate Or T.C. & Mark Sheet from the school** last attended are to be submitted by every pupil at the time of admission. Candidates coming from other school have to get their school leaving certificate/T.C. countersigned by **Inspector of School of the Area** or **C.B.S.E.**, nominee i.e. Joint Director

Children are normally admitted to Nursery class and also to higher classes depending on the availability of seats. The minimum age for admission in Nursery class is **03 years plus** as on April 1, of that year. Original valid Birth Certificate is needed to verify the age and completion of Admission procedure.

PAYMENT OF FEE

Fee and charges have to be deposited in advance on **quarterly basis** on or before **10th day of April, July, October & January**. Failing which late fee fine of Rs. 1 per day will be charged. The name of the defaulter shall be struck off from the roll on last day of the month. In case of re-admission **Rs. 200/-** shall be charged as **re-admission charges**.

FEE CONCESSION

School allows Fee Concession to the students on the basis of means & merit and guide lines issued by Govt. w.e.f. July of every academic session.

ABSENCE

All students are to follow the **school's calendar / schedule and system of leave or absence**. However, leave shall not be granted except against prior application form Parent/Guardians. In unforeseen circumstances or in an emergency, Principal may allow leave as a special case. Name will be struck off from the roll if the child remains **absent for more than seven days without information & sanction**. Absence from school for **Pretty reasons** and half day leave must be avoided.

RE-ADMISSION

Application for **Re-Admission with reason** may be considered at the sole **discretion of the Principal** before the last day of the month in which the name has been struck off. **No application for re-admission** shall be entertained **after the last day of the month** in which the name has been struck off. The **Principal may refuse re-admission without assigning any reason**. The **decision shall be final & binding**.

PROMOTION

Promotion is granted on the basis of the **whole year's performance** of the pupil and guide lines issued by C.B.S.E from time to time. If a student misses even a single test, his / her position in the class is affected. Absenteeism not only affect rank in the class but also the final result. At the time of promotion **90% attendance is compulsory for appearing in the Board /School**

Assessment (FA & SA) / Exam's The final assessment / exam meant to confirm and establish the trend of progress throughout the year.

WITHDRAWALS

A clear **one month notice in writing** or **one month's fee or whole year fee** in lieu of the notice is necessary for the withdrawal of a student from the school. All outstanding dues will have to be cleared before a **School Transfer Certificate** is issued. Details regarding above are available in school office.

DISCIPLINE

All pupils are expected to **be decent, well disciplined** and follow their proper **code of conduct**. The whole-hearted co-operation of the guardians is expected at all times in the formation of the good habits and character of their wards. **Lapses** and **omissions** are reported in the **diary** on day to day basis.

While the School lays stress on **academic standard**, it also insists on **strict punctuality, regular school attendance**, clean lines in **dress, general grooming and seriousness in studies, quality and neatness in work assigned**.

For any act of serious in discipline, the school reserves its rights to expel the student with/without warning.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All students should come to the school in proper uniform prescribed for them from Nur. to Class XII. Students in proper uniform are only allowed to attend the school.

Hair Style - All students should have neat & clean and properly combed hair style, Boys are required to have side locks upto 1/3 of their ears and their hair should not out fall below eye brows.

Navy Blue Blazer with schools logo is compulsory for from Nursery to XII std. students.

Woolen socks Black & Grey in colour

Handkerchief : Plain White (Wednesday & Saturday). Plain Sky Blue in colour other day. Patta for Sikhs Students - Navy Blue & White.

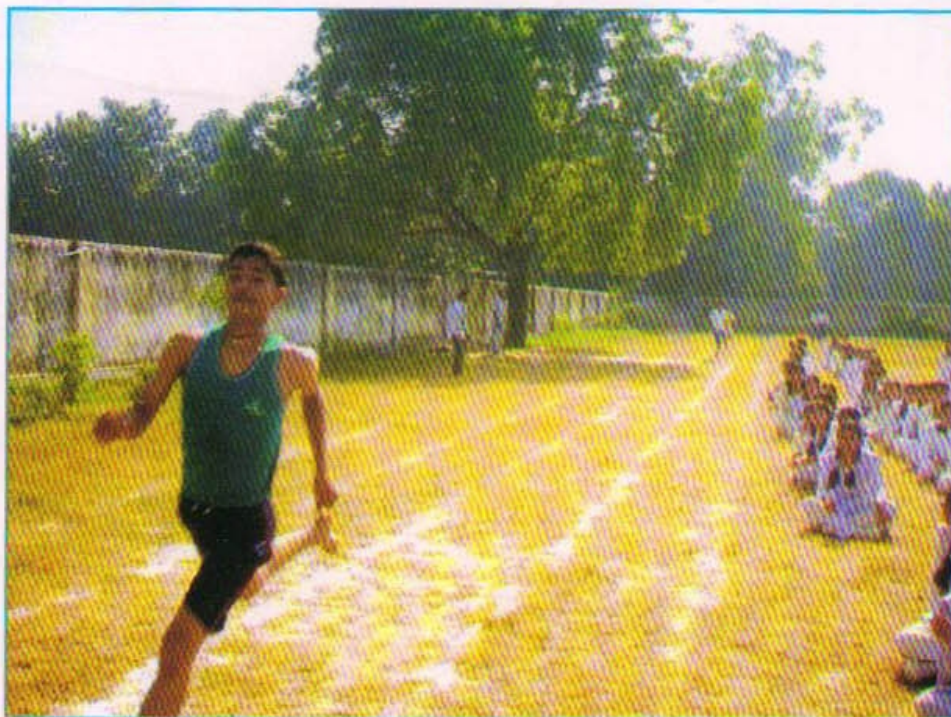
HOUSE SYSTEM
